### CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS 2008

#### DRAFT

Please note that all awards listed are competitive in nature. Eligibility for an award does not imply that an applicant will receive that award. All awards criteria and information are accurate as of the date of posting. To qualify for the following scholarships and awards a student must be graduating from HCI in June of the current year.

1. D. Ronald Bell Scholarship Award: 2@\$750 (one male recipient and one female recipient)
  - must be an active volunteer in both school and community
  - must show proficiency in the area of math
  - must be a good all round student
  - must be going to attend a post-secondary education institution
  - financial need may be a factor.
2. R. John and Agnes Adams Award: value \$1000
  - demonstrate academic excellence
  - must be taking or have taken ELA30A, ELA30B, one 30 level Math, one 30 level Science, one Social Studies 30, a second language, and two other 30 level classes
  - must be going to attend university.
3. Bruce Ogilvie Memorial Scholarship: value \$1000
  - must have high academic proficiency
  - must have some community involvement
  - must be involved in many of the following activities: athletics, fine arts, school clubs, student government
  - must be going to attend a post-secondary education institution
  - financial need may be a factor.
4. Cecilia Poole Award: value \$750
  - must be intending to enter a program in education (ie. Teacher, teacher associate, etc.)
  - must not be a multiple Awards Night winner (>\$1000 in scholarships awarded at Awards Night)
5. Masonic Scholarship: 2@ \$700
  - must demonstrate academic excellence
  - must be going to attend a post-secondary education institution (full-time)
  - may not be the recipient of another monetary award (as chosen by the Awards Committee).
6. Frances Catherine Gerwing Award: Value \$550
  - must demonstrate academic proficiency
  - must be entering the field of nursing or medicine
7. Humboldt Collegiate Institute Staff Award: value varies
  - must demonstrate academic excellence
  - must be going to attend a post-secondary institution
  - financial need may be a consideration.
8. R. C. Legion Auxiliary Award (Most Improved Student): Value \$500
  - awarded to a student who demonstrates marked improvement in academics and attitude during his/her time at H.C.I.
  - must be going to attend a post-secondary education institution

9. Henry Kloppenburg Scholarship: value \$350
  - must demonstrate academic excellence
  - must show proficiency in mathematics
  - must be going to attend a post-secondary institution
  
10. S. M. Sutherland Award: value \$350
  - must demonstrate academic proficiency
  - must demonstrate a high degree of involvement in dramatic/theater arts
  - must be going to attend a post-secondary institution (full-time)
  
11. Boyden Family Scholarship: value \$250
  - must demonstrate academic excellence with a proficiency in the sciences
  - must be attending college or university in the following year
  - must be pursuing a program in science or technology
  - must be involved in school activities and demonstrate leadership in clubs or organizations
  - must be dedicated to school work
  - must be community-minded, volunteering with the school or city
  
12. Humboldt Community Players Award: value \$250
  - must demonstrate a proficiency in visual and/or literary arts
  
13. St. Elizabeth Ladies Auxiliary Award: value \$200
  - must demonstrate academic excellence
  - must be going to attend a post-secondary institution in the field of medical sciences
  
14. Donna Batty Memorial Scholarship: Value \$200
  - has an acceptable academic standing maintained by hard work and a consistent effort to reach his/her potential
  - demonstrates kindness, caring and concern for others
  - displays a high level of organizational skills
  - participates in school activities
  - participates in community activities
  
16. Royal Canadian Legion Award: value \$150
  - must be a good all-round student
  - must demonstrate a high level of involvement in the school athletic program
  
17. Haus of Stitches Award:
  - selection based on performance in Home Economics
  
18. Evert & Ida Johnson Award \$150
  - determined by the Awards Committee of HCI
  
19. Leo Daschner Memorial: value \$ 200
  - awarded to a student who plans to enter into post secondary education in the field of agriculture or science

OTHER AWARDS: The following awards are selected by external committees and have additional requirements as

listed:

21. Knights of Columbus St. Peter's Entrance Scholarship: value \$500

- must be a son or daughter of a K of C member
- must demonstrate academic excellence
- must be going to attend St. Peter=s College
- *students must apply for this award via letter:*

22. Humboldt Chamber of Commerce: value \$500

- must demonstrate school and or community involvement, entrepreneurship, at a highly active level ( i.e. service clubs, extracurricular activities, volunteer work, charity work, recreational associations - 70% consideration)
- must have acceptable academic standing (30% consideration)
- demonstrate leadership
- the Chamber will select the recipient
- *students must apply for this award via letter, including a copy of transcript and three letters of reference to:*

23. Drs. Guilbault and Knight Scholarship: Two awards @ \$250 each (one male recipient and one female recipient)

- must demonstrate academic proficiency
- must demonstrate a high degree of involvement in athletic activities
- must be accepted at a post-secondary institution
- must attach a one to three page word-processed essay on the topic: "How school and athletics have influenced my life"
- need may be a factor
- *students must forward a copy of the application form and the essay to the HCI Office*

24. Humboldt Junior Chamber/Jaycee Scholarship: value \$500

- be a graduate of Humboldt Collegiate Institute and attending his/her final semester at this facility
- meet the academic achievement of 70%
- be accepted at a recognized post-secondary institute
- demonstrate good citizenship, character and leadership
- *complete an application in full and provide all required information, letters and documents in order for his/her application to be considered.*

Include the following with application:

- a transcript of the student's marks or a photocopy of the Permanent Report Card, or typed copy accompanied by the Principal's signature
- a letter from a member of the community writing on behalf of the candidate in regards to his/her leadership qualities, community activities and character
